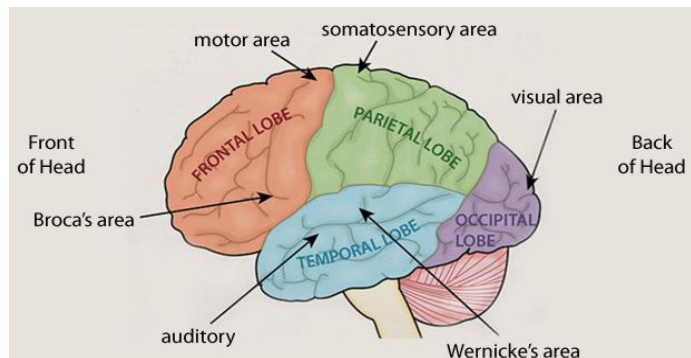
Please complete the following 3 tasks:

Task 1: Different Approaches: Create a summary of the following topics,
