- You will complete different science experiments throughout the year to test hypothesis' and learn about science in the wider world

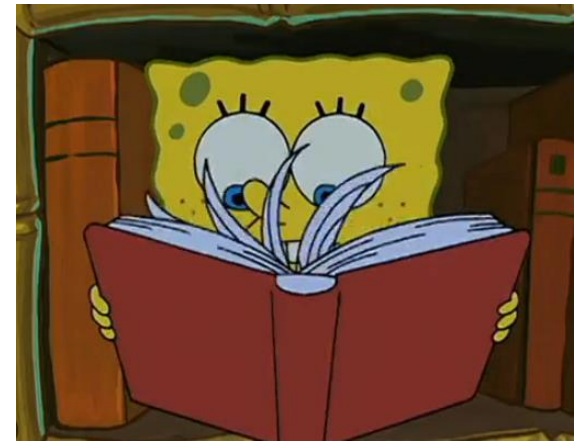

- **All students have library borrowing accounts, so please come and use the library to borrow books.**

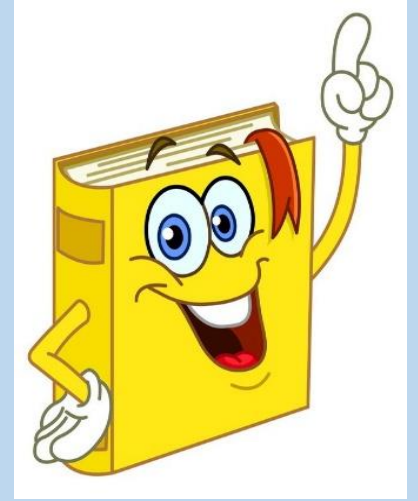
Love to Read? Want to share your love with like-minded people?
