Families – parents/ carers

We will:

- Ensure children arrive to school on time, every day, properly equipped to learn and in correct uniform, in line with our Attendance and Uniform Policy.
- Actively support children in undertaking homework and work missed through absence.
- Actively support the school in promoting its values and encourage children to be respectful and kind and aware of the effect their behaviour can have on others.

- Attend consultation and relevant information evenings.
- Inform the school of any changes in home circumstances that may affect a child's welfare or ability to learn.
- Inform the school promptly of any change of home contact details.
- Ensure all communication with the school is respectful and constructive.
- Support and monitor children's use of social media and report any concerns.
