



Dear Sixth Form student,

As you will be aware, Wednesday 1st February is the first of a series of strike days declared by the NEU (National Education Union) as part of a national campaign.

As a result, we will be closed to students in Years 7 to 10, but will remain open to students in Year 11 and the Sixth Form, who we have prioritised due to the closeness of your exams.

During the day, Sixth Form students will have access to the common room and study room all day as normal for independent study, and Shades will be open for break and lunch.
