Parents and carers of all Year 10 students are invited to attend this event in Lansdown Hall. There will be a presentation from members of the Senior Leadership Team to outline our Key Stage 4 curriculum and the support that students can expect as well as an overview of Wellsway's careers package. This will be followed by a series of short presentations in the hall and classrooms by our curriculum leaders that parents and carers can attend to find out more about the specific subjects and advice about supporting your child with their learning. This will include guidance relating to exam boards and revision materials.

The main aims of the evening will be to:

- Give an overview of the Key Stage 4 curriculum that Year 10 and 11 students will follow.
- Explain the grading system in place for GCSEs and vocational subjects.
- Give an overview of the support, advice and guidance in place for students.
- Explain how we support students with careers.
- Explain the key aspects of Key Stage 4 subjects and provide important information on deadlines and course features.
- Give some practical ideas about how you can support your child with their Key Stage 4 studies.
- Answer any queries you may have around Inclusion/ SEN/D and Access Arrangements.
